Canopy Café

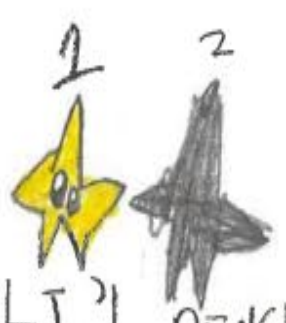
The transition class at The Canopy School have opened The Canopy Café. On Fridays, students and staff can purchase Hot chocolate, coffee, and donuts.

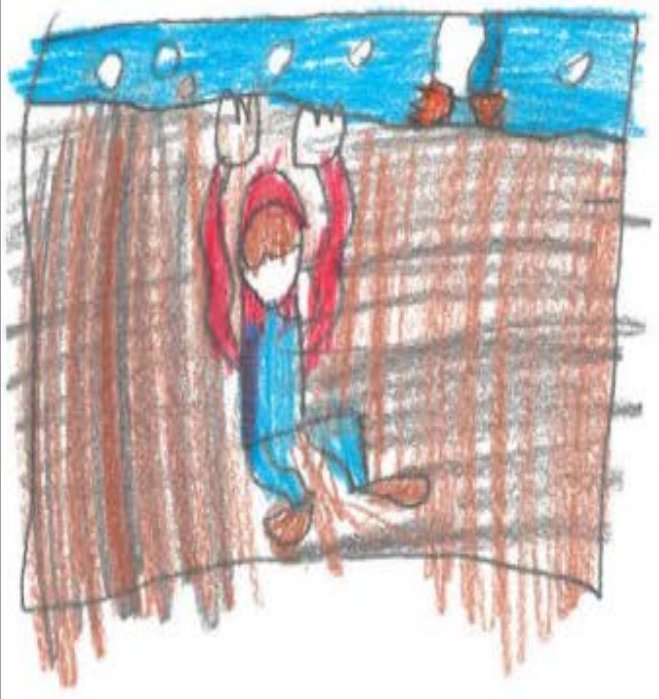
