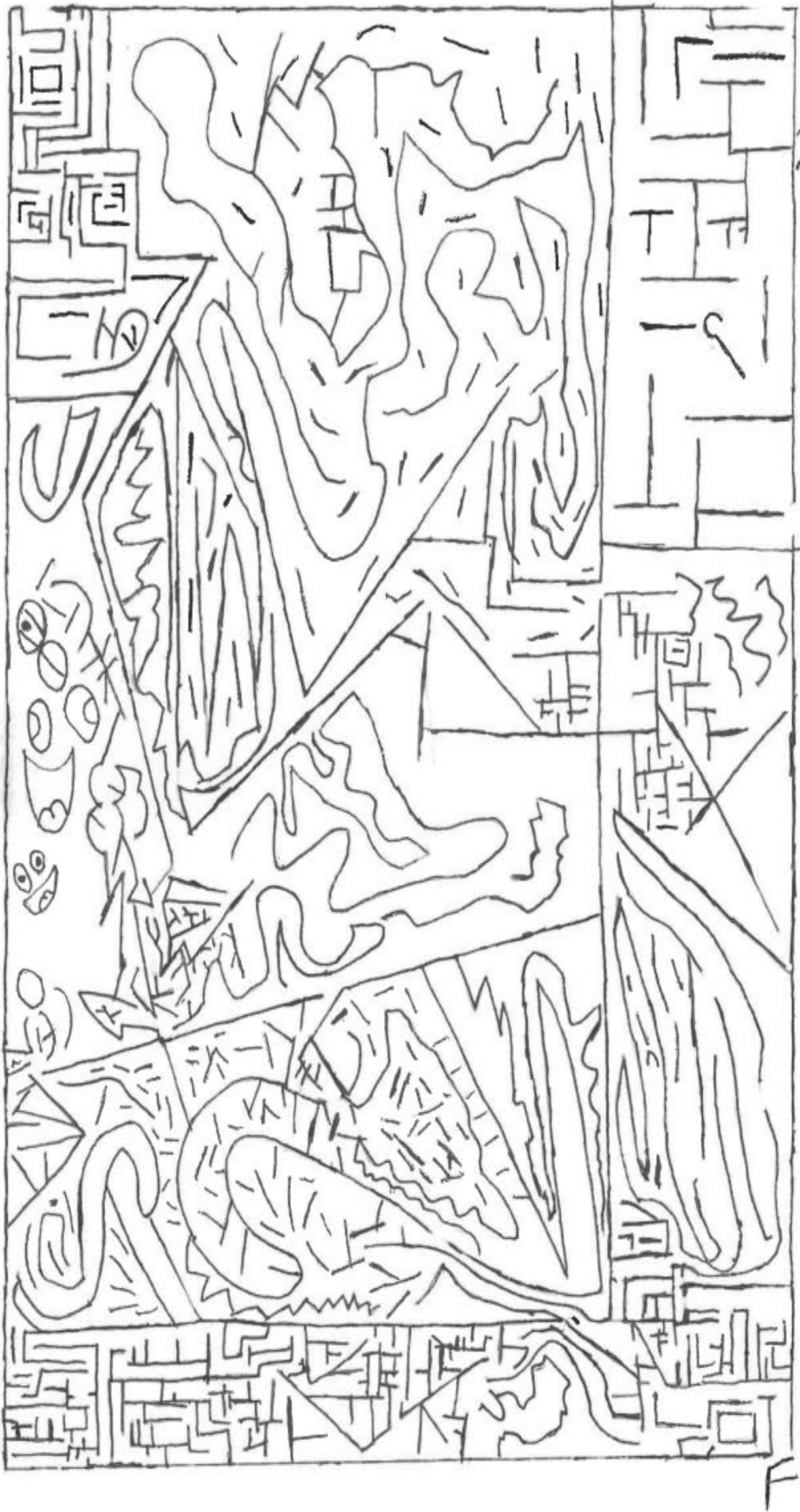

Abraham Lincoln created the secret service on the day he was killed.

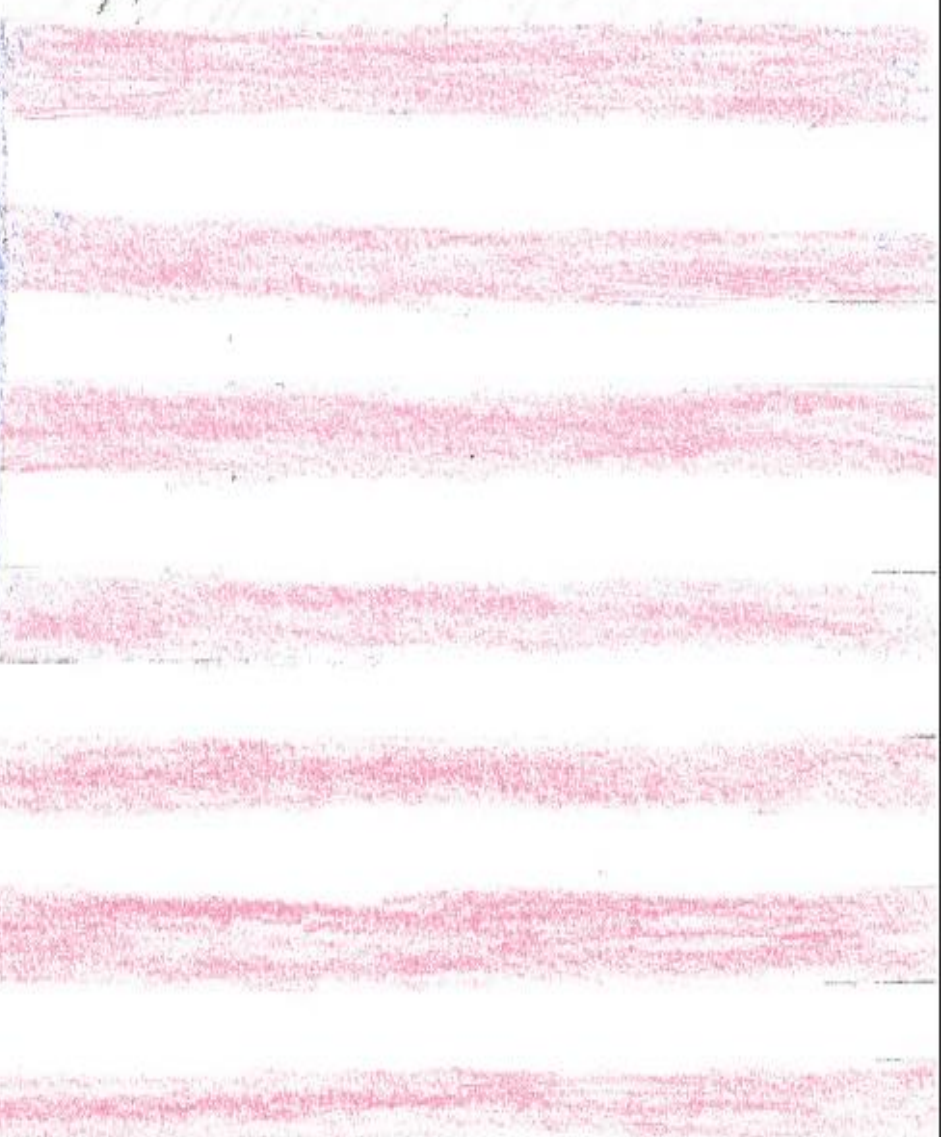
